

THE LEW DAVIES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Lewis "Lew" Davies was born September 30, 1917 in Oregon City, Oregon where he grew up. He graduated from Oregon City High School. Lew went to Fresno State where he earned a teaching degree.

He was a World War II veteran and survived the Battle of the Bulge, a brutal assault against the Germans in the Ardennes in Belgium. The six week battle lasted from December 16, 1944 to January 25, 1945.

Mr. Davies taught science at Marshfield High School for the entire 30 years of his teaching career. He retired in 1980. In addition to teaching, he was the MHS tennis team coach and ran the summer tennis program.

His family set up the Lew Davies Memorial Scholarship fund in his memory in 2000.
